- 2. Those lying between a North and South line running through Courtenay Head to the Mainland, including Hampton Harbor, and a North and South line running through the North-East of Dolphin Island to the Mainland.
- 3. Those lying between the mouths of the Fortescue and Cane Rivers, extending six miles from shore.
