WHEREAS by "The Imported Stock Act, 1876," it is provided that it shall be lawful for the Governor of the said Colony to acquire and set apart, by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette*, such ground as may be required for one or more Quarantine Stations, on which the necessary sheds and appurtenances may be erected for the purpose of the said Act; AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient by me, the Administrator, to set apart a Temporary Quarantine Station at Fremantle: NOW THEREFORE I, the said Administrator, in exercise of the powers in me vested as aforesaid, do hereby set apart as a Temporary Quarantine Station at Fremantle, for the purposes of the said Act, all that piece or parcel of land, being Fremantle Town Lot 219, as shown in the plans and records of the Survey Department of the said Colony.

ALTERATION IN NORTH CHANNEL, WIDE BAY BAR.

**I**N consequence of the Eastern Spit, in the North Channel, having extended considerably to the westward, it will be necessary, in order to clear it, to keep open the triangular beacons on Inskip Point four times their width to the westward, which will lead through the Channel with not less than 17 feet at low water. As there is now 13 feet at low water in the South Channel, vessels are strongly recommended not to use the North Channel at night.
