PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir WILLIAM CLEAVER FRANCIS ROBINSON, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Western Australia and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of "The Bank Holidays Act, 1884," I, SIR WILLIAM CLEAVER FRANCIS ROBINSON, Governor as aforesaid, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint

Tuesday, the 23rd May,

a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout the Colony.
