By His Excellency Sir WILLIAM CLEAVER FRANCIS ROBINSON, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Western Australia and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of "The Bank Holidays Act, 1884," I, SIR WILLIAM CLEAVER FRANCIS ROBINSON, G.C.M.G., Governor of the said Colony, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Bank Holidays at the places respectively specified, viz. :—

York, Wednesday, 25th October instant.

Newcastle, Thursday, 26th October instant.

Northam, Friday, 27th October instant.
