### "The Roads Act, 1888."

THE Sussex Roads Board, in pursuance of the powers vested in the said Board under and by virtue of the said Act, doth hereby make and publish the following By-law:—

That the weights carried on vehicles using the public roads in the Sussex Roads District must not exceed the following, under a penalty of not exceeding Five pounds, recoverable from the person in charge of vehicle so offending:

One pair of wheels ...	two tons
Two " " ...	three tons
