(42 Vict., No. 31, Section 26.)

## SCHEDULE.

- No. 1 Deviation (known as the Mahogany Creek Section).—Commencing at 22 miles 40 chains, and terminating at 38 miles 13 chains 56 links. Total length, 14 miles and 1 link.
- No. 3 Deviation.—Commencing at 41 miles 13 chains 25 links, and terminating at 42 miles 47 chains 25 links. Total length, 1 mile 53 chains 1 link.
- No. 6 Deviation.—Commencing at 44 miles 31 chains 64 links, and terminating at 45 miles 73 chains 6 links. Total length, 1 mile 55 chains 53 links.
- No. 9 Deviation.—Commencing at 54 miles 29 chains 92 links, and terminating at 55 miles 61 chains 16 links. Total length, 1 mile 35 chains 61 links.
