PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Lieut.-Colonel Sir GERARD SMITH, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Western Australia and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

**THEREAS in the sixtieth year of the reign of Her Majesty, a certain Bill was passed by the Legislature of the said Colony intituled:--"An Act to further amend the Constitution Act, 1889, and to amend the Constitution Act Amendment Act, 1893;" And whereas such Bill was assented to by the Governor in the name and on behalf of the Queen, but the operation of the said Act was by Section 17 suspended until the signification in the Colony of Her Majesty's pleasure thereon: Now THEREFORE I, Lieut.-Colonel SIR GERARD SMITH, Governor of the said Colony, do hereby signify and proclaim that such Act has been laid before Her Majesty in Council, and that Her Majesty has been pleased to declare Her assent to the same.

PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA,

GERARD SMITH. (L.S.)

By His Excellency Lieut.-Colonel Sir Gerard Smith, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Western Australia and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

HEREAS the Parliament of Western Australia stands prorogued until the 12th day of April instant; And whereas for divers weighty reasons it is desirable that the Legislative Assembly should be dissolved: Now therefore, in pursuance of the powers and authority in me vested as Governor of the said Colony, I, Lieut-Colonel Sir Gerard Smith, K.C.M.G., do hereby dissolve the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia from and after this date, and the same stands dissolved accordingly.
