**B**Y virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by Sections 80 and 88 of "The Electoral Act, 1899"  
(63 Vict., No. 20), I, Sir ALEXANDER CAMPBELL ONSLOW, Knight, Administrator of the  
Government of the said Colony, do hereby, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, fix the  
Court House at Geraldton as the place of Nomination and the Chief Polling Place for the Electoral  
District of Geraldton.

July, 1900.
