BY virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by Sections 80 and 88 of "The Electoral Act, 1899" (63 Vict., No. 20), I, SIR ALEXANDER CAMPBELL ONSLOW, Knight, Administrator of the Government of the said Colony, do hereby, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, fix the Municipal Chambers at Claremont, the Municipal Chambers at Victoria Park, the Court House at Guildford, the Court House at Coolgardie, the Clyde Mine, the Court House at Norseman, and the Court House at Southern Cross, as the Places of Nomination, and the Chief Polling Places for the Claremont, South Perth, Guildford, Coolgardie, Mt. Burges, Dundas, and Yilgarn Electoral Districts, respectively.
