Explanatory Notices.

1. The nineteen Goldfields of the State are herein arranged according to their geographical position, commencing with Kimberley in the North, and terminating with Donnybrook in the South-West. Six Goldfields are sub-divided into seventeen districts, and in the case of these Goldfields the district in which the Warden has fixed his headquarters is placed first in the return. The mining centres have, in all cases, been shown in alphabetical order under the heading of their respective districts, and, finally, the groups of mines which make up the mining centres have been set down in similar fashion.

* * * * *

2. These Returns represent all treatments reported to Mining Registrars as completed during the month; but, as Regulations 45 and 98 allow seven days in which to declare such results, the gold production of the State cannot be ascertained earlier than some ten days after the end of each month when the totals of each district will be announced, followed at a few days' interval by full details.

* * * * *

3. During the last week of each month the holders of leases and registered claims, as well as the managers of public crushing plants, will receive from the Mining Registrar of the district,—

- (a.) Two copies of Schedule 11 or 22, according as they may be applicable to machinery areas, leases, or registered claims.
- (b.) One addressed envelope, impressed with the office and frank stamp of the local district in which the return is to be forwarded to the Mining Registrar.

From this, it will be gathered that all cost to the lessees and managers has been avoided, and the labour of completing the returns has been reduced to a minimum.

* * * * *

4. As one of the principal intentions of Regulation 45 is to credit each district with the amount of gold won therefrom, managers of gold-extracting plants, when taking delivery of ore presented for treatment, are particularly requested to insist upon the exact locality being declared from which such ore was derived. As it is imperatively necessary that the results from ore so treated should be in the hands of the Mining Registrar of the district from which it was obtained on the seventh day of each month, it behoves all managers to post the return as many days before that date as it will occupy in transit.

* * * * *

5. The difference between the statement headed "Total Production of Gold, in ounces, showing the gross weight reported to the Mines Department, etc.," and the one compiled by H.M. Customs is to be accounted for by the fact that the exportation of gold started, practically, with the inception of the industry; whereas the mode of collecting returns adopted by the Mines Department is the elaboration of a system established some few years ago. Up to that date, therefore, no good basis for an exact comparison can be found. As to the discrepancy which exists at present, the assumption is that the whole of the gold won from the soil is not reported to the department.

6. Notification will be gladly received by the Statist, Perth, of any omissions that may occur or corrections that may be necessary, the aim of the department being to arrive at as accurate an account as possible of the gold production of Western Australia.

ROYAL MINT, PERTH BRANCH.

On 20th June, 1899, His Excellency the Governor declared the Perth Branch of the Royal Mint to be open for the receipt of gold for coinage.

Subject to the Regulations, any person may deposit gold at the Mint in his own name. Those who cannot attend personally for the purpose may send the gold by an agent, through the post, or under Police escort.

A circular can be obtained from the Deputy Master of the Mint giving all necessary information for intending depositors, conditions of the Escort Service, Coining Regulations, etc., etc.

Parcels up to 43 ounces gross may be sent through the post.

An Escort Service is provided by the Police Department for parcels of all sizes. The consignor pays for the carriage by coach or train, but the escort charges are collected by the Mint.

Forms for use in connection with gold sent to the Mint by post or under Police escort can be obtained at the Mint.

The charges for the conversion of gold into coin are as follows:—

(1.) *For Assaying and Refining:*

A minimum charge of 4s. is made for all weights up to 48ozs.

From 50ozs. to 500ozs.	an addition at the rate of 10d. for every 10ozs. or part of	100ozs.
" 501ozs. " 1,000ozs.	" 1s. 8d. " 20 "	200ozs.
