The Electoral Act, 1899.

HIS Excellency the Administrator in Council has been pleased to appoint, under Section 84 of "The Electoral Act, 1899" (63 Vict., No. 20), the following persons to take the vote of any elector whose qualification is not residential only, and who resides more than 30 miles from the nearest Polling Place of the Province or District for which he desires to vote, or who, after the issue of the writ and before
