#### Extension of Date of Pilbarra Election.

W HEREAS representations have been made to me by certain Electors in the Pilbarra District that the date fixed by me in the Writ issued on the 24th instant for holding an Election in that Electoral District has given too short a time between the day of nomination and the day of election, owing to the want of means of communication in such a large and scattered district, and will thereby prevent many electors from recording their votes: Now, therefore, acting in accordance with the provisions of Section 118 of the 63rd of Victoria, No. 20, I do hereby extend the time for holding such Election as aforesaid until the 17th day of January, 1902; and the time for returning the writ until the 23rd day of January, 1902.
