Declaring the Population of Boulder Municipality.

PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, }

By His Excellency Sir EDWARD ALBERT STONE, Knight, Administrator
of the Government in and over the State of Western Australia and
its Dependencies, etc., etc., etc.

WHEREAS by Section 11, Sub-sections (g) and (k) of "The Municipal Institutions Act, 1900," the Governor may, by Proclamation, determine and alter, within the limits prescribed by the said Act, the number of Councillors assigned to any Municipality, and declare the number of the population of any Municipality: AND WHEREAS a Petition has been presented to me with the Common Seal of the Boulder Municipality, praying for the declaration of the population of the said Municipality: AND WHEREAS the said Petition was publicly advertised in the *Government Gazette* on the 10th day of October, 1902: NOW, THEREFORE, I, Sir Edward Albert Stone, Knight, Administrator of the Government as aforesaid, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers so vested in me by the said Act, do by this my Proclamation declare the population of the Municipality of Boulder to be over Five thousand, and do also alter the number of Councillors assigned to the said Municipality from nine to twelve.

November, 1902.
