THE CENTRAL BOARD OF HEALTH.

PART 1.

8A. Any expense incurred by the Central Board in cleansing, purifying, and disinfecting any houses, premises, or place shall be paid by the owner or occupier thereof to the Central Board, and may be recovered by the Central Board by action in any Court of competent jurisdiction.

THE HEALTH ACT, 1898.

THE CENTRAL BOARD OF HEALTH.

THE Regulations made by the Central Board of Health under Section 9 of "The Health Act Amendment Act, 1902," and of Section 111 of "The Health Act, 1898," and published in the *Government Gazette* of the 15th March, 1902, are amended by adding the following Regulations, as under :--

Part 3.

24. No vessel or ship conveying goods of any description from the Port of Fremantle shall be allowed to come alongside of any wharf or landing at or adjacent to the City of Perth, or discharge any goods or cargo from such vessel or ship unless permission is given by the Inspector or other authorised Officer of the Central Board of Health.

25. Before removing cargo from such vessel or ship :---

- (a.) Every package shall be separately examined and passed by the Inspector of the Central Board before being slung.
- (b.) Every package not passed on such inspection shall be dealt with in such manner as the Inspector (subject to the instructions of the Central Board) may direct.
- (c.) No package whatsoever shall be landed from any vessel or ship without the consent of the Inspector, nor until so inspected or passed, or otherwise dealt with.

26. No cargo shall be discharged from any ship or vessel before 7 a.m. and after 6 p.m., except by permission of the Central Board.

The Central Board hereby authorises, requires, and directs the Perth Local Board of Health and its officers to superintend and see to the execution of these Regulations. By order of the Central Board of Health,
