1. A spray injection condenser having a pipe main as c for delivering cold water under pressure, said main having a rectangular branch or branches as c2, provided with a perforated outlet or outlets as c3 and which are held in position by flanges as d and bolts as d1, substantially as and for the purposes herein set forth and as illustrated in the attached drawings.

2. A spray injection condenser having a steam feed pipe as a1, formed with upwardly directed outlets as a2, for delivering a body of steam shower-wise into a condensing chamber as a, substantially as and for the purposes herein set forth and as illustrated in the attached drawings.

3. A spray injection condenser for breaking down and condensing steam by means of cold pressure water jets and comprised of a chamber

as a, of a steam feed pipe as a1 having upwardly-directed outlets as a2 of a cold pressure feed water main as c having spray injection outlets as c3 and of a water discharge pipe as b, all in combination and substantially as herein described and as illustrated in the attached drawings.

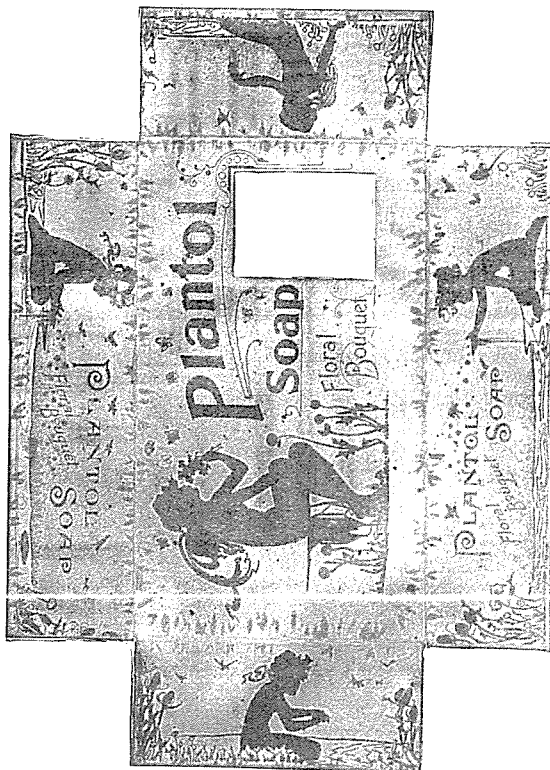

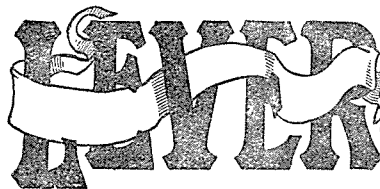
