Application No. 4311.—JAMES STUBBERSFIELD, of Murrin Murrin, Western Australia, Miner, "*Improvements in the construction of Steam Boilers.*"—Dated 3rd March, 1903.

Claims:—

1. In steam boilers, the use of divisional walls as *d*, which extend above water level and at their lower part are formed with sluice or nozzle openings as *e*, substantially as and for the purposes herein set forth and as illustrated in the attached drawings.

2. In steam boilers a final or mud chamber as *k* provided with a blow-off plug in combination with compartments as *f* to *j* having openings as *e* for means of communication substantially as and for the purposes herein set forth and as illustrated in the attached drawings.

3. The peculiar construction of divisional walls as *d* with openings as *e* and with a final or mud chamber as *k* in combination with a steam boiler, substantially as herein set forth and as illustrated in the attached drawings.

In an improved lighting and shading apparatus for sporting and amusement grounds, an inverted reflecting trough constructed of any suitable material and having a vertical side, vertical ends, horizontal top and inclined side, so that the rays of light are reflected on the performers and shaded from the spectators, substantially as described and illustrated in the accompanying drawings.

2. In an improved lighting and shading apparatus for sporting and amusement grounds, an inverted reflecting trough constructed of any suitable material, of the design and construction and for the purpose as described in Claim 1 and its application to and use in illuminating sporting grounds, such as running or cycling tracks or other amusement, sporting or recreation grounds, substantially as described and illustrated in the accompanying drawings.

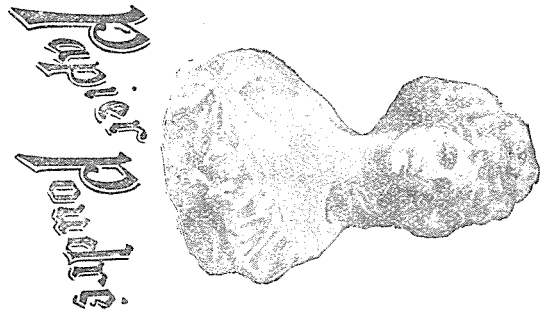
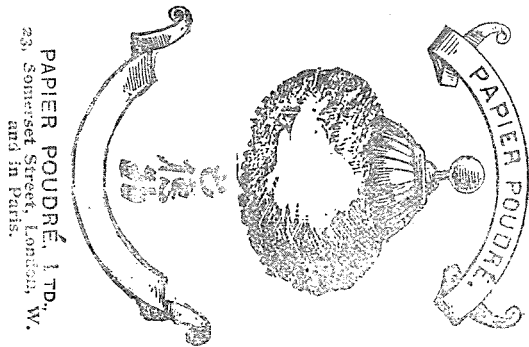
