#### Claims:

1. The improvement in the marking of concrete street pavements and ways, and floors, and the like, consisting of the use of moulds having a pattern or design on their under surfaces and the interposition between the said mould, and the plastic composite or concrete surface of the pavement of a wet or damp cloth or sheet of fabric which will hold moisture substantially as herein described and explained.  
2. In the improvement as set out in the preceding (first) claim the wetting or dampening of a calico sheet or other fabric in a solution of silicate of soda in water substantially as herein described and explained.

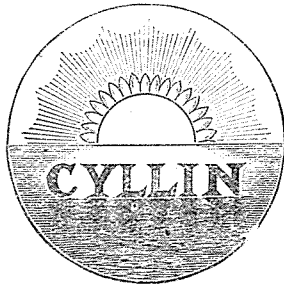

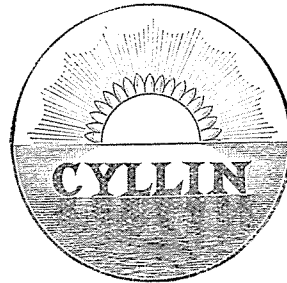
