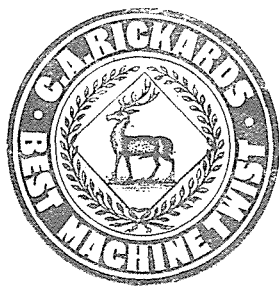

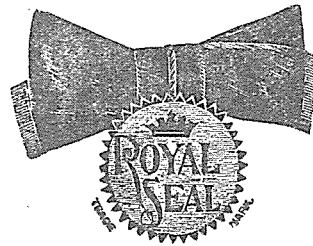


The said Trade Mark has been used by applicants and their predecessor in business in respect of Sewing Silk since the month of February, 1870.

Claim is made to substitute, in use, for the words "Best Machine Twist" other words descriptive of other kinds of silk included in the specification.

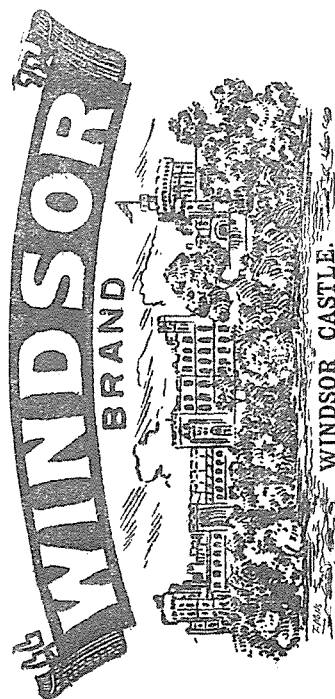
