## PROCLAMATION

Western Australia. to wirs.
k'Red. G. D. BEDFORD, Governor. [L.S.]

D HEREAS by "The Constitution Act, 1889," it is provided that the Governor may, whenever be may think fit, by Proclamation or otherwise, prorogue the Parliament: Now therefore I, the said Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by "The Constitution Act, 1889," do by this Proclamation prorogue the Parliament as from the fifth day of October instant until the seventh day of November next.
