WHEREAS by "The Land Act Amendment Act, 1902" (1 and 2 Edward VII., No. 20), and "The Land Act Amendment Act, 1905" (5 Edward VII., No. 22), the Governor may, by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette*, after the opinion of the Road Board of the District has been requested, close any road or reservation for a road which may have been surveyed or shown as a road on any plan published by the Department of Lands and Surveys: Provided such road is not within the limit of a Municipality, and has not been declared a Government road or a road under "The Roads Act," or any Act amending the same: AND WHEREAS the roads hereinafter described have been surveyed and shown as roads on the under-mentioned plans as published by the Department of Lands and Surveys: AND it is desirable to close such roads: AND WHEREAS the opinion of the undermentioned Road Boards has been requested: NOW THEREFORE I, Sir Edward Albert Stone, Knight, Lieutenant-Governor as aforesaid, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby declare the said surveyed roads to be closed.

By His Excellency Sir Edward Albert Stone, Knight, Lieutenant-Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, etc., etc., etc.

WHEREAS by "The Stock Diseases Act, 1895," it is provided that it shall be lawful for the Governor to acquire and set apart, by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette*, such ground as may be required for one or more Quarantine Stations: And whereas it is deemed expedient by me, the said Governor, to set apart Temporary Stations: Now therefore I, the said Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in me as aforesaid, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby set apart as a Temporary Quarantine Area for the purpose of the said Act, that portion of the State as described hereunder:—

Bounded by lines starting from the present boundary at the 45-mile post on the Eastern Railway, and extending Northward along said Railway to a point in prolongation South of the Easternmost boundary of Swan Location 1317; thence North to its North-East corner; thence North-North-Eastward to the North-West corner of Coondle Estate; thence North-Eastward along the latter's North-Western boundary and the South Boundaries of Avon Location 4 to the latter's East corner; thence due East to a point North of the Meckering Railway Station, and thence South passing through said Station to the North-West boundary of Location 3409, near Mount Kokeby; thence South-Westward passing along the North boundary of Avon Location d to the North Dandalup Railway Station; thence North-Eastward to the South-East corner of Avon Location 3444, on the Helena River; thence North to its North-East corner, and thence North-North-Westward to the starting point.
