ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Executive Council Chambers, at Perth, the Eighteenth day of December, 1907.

*Present:*

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor  
The Honourables—The Premier.

WHEREAS by "The Water Boards Act, 1904," the Governor is empowered by Order in Council to constitute the district of a local authority a Water Area, under such name as may be directed: And whereas under the said Act the Governor is empowered by Order in Council to constitute a Water Board to manage and control such area: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, does

hereby constitute the District of the Municipality of Broome to be a Water Area, under the name of the Broome Water Area, and does hereby appoint the Broome Municipal Council to be a Water Board, under the name of the Broome Water Board, for the administration of the Act within such Area.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the 1st day of January, 1908, and to cancel the Order in Council appearing in the *Government Gazette* of 21st December, 1906.

WHEREAS by "The Insect Pests Amendment Act, 1898," the Governor is empowered, by Order in Council gazetted from time to time, to make such regulations as he deems necessary for any part of the purposes mentioned in Section 24 of the said Act: And whereas it is deemed expedient to add to the regulations gazetted on the thirteenth day of December, 1907, governing the importation of seed potatoes: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, does hereby make the following additional regulations under the said Act.

## Additional Regulations.

4. In the event of parcels of over 5cwt. being imported the importer may, at the discretion of the Department, plant same on his own land when such land has been duly gazetted as a Quarantine Area.

5. In the event of potatoes being planted on owner's land, they shall for the purposes of this Act be deemed to remain in the possession of the Department, and neither the imported seed nor the resultant crop shall be removed therefrom without the permission in writing of an Inspector under the Act.

6. The charges for inspection on potatoes quarantined on private lands shall be:—

Per cwt. or part thereof.	
Inspection at Port of Entry .. .. .	6d.
Per cwt. or part thereof.	
Inspection of crop when lifted .. .. .	6d.
