the said Bulong Local Court shall be transferred to and continue in the Kanowna Local Court, and that all records of the said Bulong Local Court (the holding of which is discontinued) shall also be transferred to the said Kanowna Local Court as from the 1st of June, 1908.

In pursuance off the powers conferred by "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1906," the Mayor and Councillors of the City of Perth do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. Paragraph (a) of Section 1 of By-law No. 27 regulating the wholesale sale of fish is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is substituted in lieu thereof:—
 - (a.) The word "Market" whenever occurring shall mean the market provided by the Council for the wholesale sale of fish comprising the portion of the Perth City Markets, situate at the intersection of William and Wellington Streets, Perth, hereinafter described, viz.:—

Commencing at a point in the Northern wall of the Market buildings, such point being the Western side of

the most Easterly entrance from the Station yard, and thence by a line bearing Southerly 22 feet, thence by a line bearing South 56½deg. West a distance of 35ft. 6in., thence by a line bearing West 1deg. North 12ft. 6in., thence by a line bearing North 1 deg. East a distance of 6 feet, thence by a line bearing North 13 deg. West to the North boundary wall of the Market buildings, thence Easterly by the said North wall a distance of 41 feet to the point of commencement, as shown on a certified drawing deposited in the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Perth, and coloured pink on the said drawing.

- 1. Section No. 2 of By-law No. 11 regulating the inspection of fish is hereby repealed, and the following section is substituted in lieu thereof:—
 - 2. That portion of the "Perth City Markets" hereinafter described is hereby specified and appointed as the place at which all fish must be produced for inspection before being sold or offered for or exposed for sale within the district of the Perth Local Board of Health, viz:—

Commencing at a point in the Northern boundary wall of the Market buildings, such point being the Western side of the most Easterly entrance from the station yard, and thence by a line bearing Southerly 22feet, thence by a line bearing Southerly 22feet, thence by a line bearing South 56½ deg. West a distance of 35ft. 6in., thence by a line bearing West 1deg. North 12ft. 6in., thence by a line bearing North 1deg. East a distance of 6 feet, thence by a line bearing North 1deg. West to the North boundary wall of the Market buildings, thence Easterly by the said North Wall a distance of 41 feet to the point of com-

mencement, as shown on a certified drawing deposited in the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Perth, and coloured pink on the said drawing.

The Regulations made by the Fremantle Harbour Trust Commissioners, dated 6th September, 1907, are hereby amended as follows:

REGULATION No. 217A.

Vessel and Gear to be kept free and clear of Cranes, etc.

The Master of every vessel shall keep the same and every part thereof, and all boats, rigging, ropes, hawsers and other equipment or apparel thereof and all sers and other equipment or apparet thereof and all gangways belonging thereto or used or intended to be used in connection with his vessel at all times free and clear of and from all cranes, running cranes, railway lines, engines, trucks, gear and plant or other things on the wharves or jetties within the harbour, or forming part thereof respectively, and that whether the said cranes, running cranes, engines, trucks, gear and plant are stationary or in use.

ADDITIONAL BY-LAWS OF THE YILGARN ROAD BOARD.

WHEREAS by "The Roads Act, 1902," the Road Board of any District is empowered to make By-laws for all or any purposes in the said Act mentioned, the Yilgarn Road Board, in pursuance of the powers vested in the said Board, under and by virtue of the said Act, and of every other authority enabling it on that behalf, doth hereby make and publish the following By-laws for the regulation of road transport, motor power, traction, and heavy traffic, and for special license fees for vehicles engaged in the same.

- 1. That no vehicle or engine, or motor, which, together with its load, shall weigh more than fifteen tons gross weight, shall be allowed to cross any bridge or culvert within the District.
- 2. That, no engine or motor shall draw more than two trailers at one time on a road.
- 3. That when crossing a bridge or culvert, the speed of a motor or traction engine, loaded or unloaded, shall be limited to six miles per hour maximum, or three miles per hour minimum speed.
- 4. That no motor or engine shall pass, at a speed exceeding three miles an hour, any person who shall be riding or driving any horse or other animal.
- 5. When an engine or motor shall meet or overtake any horse or animal, and such horse or animal shall become restless, or likely to get beyond control of the person in charge thereof, such engine or motor shall stop until such horse or animal has become quiet or passed, and shall at all times give the right of way to such horse or animal.
- 6. No engine or motor shall be driven round the corners formed by the junction of any roads in the District, or across the intersection of any of the said roads, at a pace exceeding three miles an hour.

- 7. No person shall, between sunset and sunrise, drive any engine or motor within the District unless there are attached thereto, and to any trailer therewith, two sidelights, both of which shall exhibit a light in the direction in which such engine, motor, and trailer are proceeding, and are at all times during those hours to be kept lighted.
- 8. That a yearly license fee of Twenty-five Pounds shall be paid for every engine or motor used for traction purposes within the District; and that a yearly license fee of Ten shillings per wheel shall be paid for every trailer used for traction purposes on roads within the District. No such engine or motor or trailer shall be used for traction purposes unless licensed by the Board. The above amounts shall be additional to those prescribed under "The Cart and Carriage Licensing Act, 1876."

 9. That no unsuitable place shall be selected as a constant traction purpose.
- 9. That no unsuitable place shall be selected as a camping or stopping-place for an engine or motor, and the roadway at all times shall be left clear for traffic.
- 10. That no water shall be taken for steaming purposes, by any engine or motor, from any well or dam within the Road Board jurisdiction.
- 11. The owner and person in charge of every engine or motor shall travel the roads, bridges, and culverts at his own risk, and shall be liable to pay for any damage done.
- 12. The owner of every licensed vehicle plying for hire, or engaged in heavy or other traffic, and of every licensed engine or motor, shall have their license number affixed on some conspicuous part of such engine, vehicle, or motor, and every person who shall refuse or neglect to have such number so affixed shall be guilty of an offence against this By-law, and shall, on conviction, be liable to a penalty not exceeding Two pounds (£2).

Penalties.

- 13. Every person who does, permits, or suffers any act, matter, or thing contrary to these By-laws, or commits or permits any breach thereof, shall be deemed guilty of an offence against these By-laws, and where not otherwise provided shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Twenty Pounds for every such offence.
- 14. All penalties and other sums recovered under the provisions of these By-laws shall, unless otherwise provided, he paid to the Board, and shall become the property of and form part of the ordinary income of the district, except so much as may be payable to an informer.

Alteration of By-law relative to Heavy Traffic.

That subsections "a" and "b" of By-law No. 54 be rescinded, and the following substituted:—

- (a.) For vehicles of two wheels, ten shillings per
- (b.) For vehicles of four wheels, two pounds per annum.
- It is hereby resolved by the Yilgarn Road Board, and with the approval and confirmation of His Excellency the tovernor in Council, that the above additional By-laws shall be in force within the District controlled by the said Board, from the date of publication thereof in the Government Gazette.
