BREADSTUFFS STATISTICS, 1908.

1.—*Last Year's Estimates.*

In June, 1907, it was estimated that the mean population of the State for the then current year would total approximately 265,000, that the consumption per head of wheat for food, etc., would average 7.9 bushels, giving a total of 2,093,500 bushels, and that the seed requirements for the year would amount to about 500,000 bushels. The quantities required for the State's use were thus estimated at 2,593,500 bushels, and as the supply available early in the year amounted to 3,465,418 bushels, consisting of 706,851 bushels, or the equivalent in wheat and flour, carried over from

the previous year, plus the year's wheat production of 2,758,567 bushels, it was computed that 871,918 bushels would be available for export.

2.—*Last Year's Statistics.*

Now that the actual figures for the year as collected can be given, it will be seen, from the following comparative statement, in which all quantities of flour have been reduced to their equivalent in wheat, that the estimates have, in most instances, been very closely verified:—

From this it is apparent that the estimate of 7.9 bushels of wheat per head of the mean population for food or other purposes, instead of being too high, as it was in some quarters regarded, was, if anything, just a fraction below the truth. It must, however, be pointed out that in this State, as elsewhere, considerable quantities of wheat are utilised for other purposes than human consumption, viz., as food for fowls, pigs, etc., and it not being at present practicable to separate these from the total quantity consumed, an allowance must, of course, be made in the average per head, though the extent of this allowance cannot yet be exactly determined.

3.—*Estimates for Current Year.*

The result of this comparison furnishes a sound basis for an estimate with regard to the current year. It has been again ascertained, as in the previous year, what amounts of wheat and flour were in store

throughout the State at the end of 1907, and carried over to 1908, the total quantity then available being equivalent to 411,967 bushels of wheat.

According to the wheat returns for the past season, now published, it would appear that the aggregate wheat yield for the whole State was approximately 2,933,350 bushels.

Estimating then, the mean population for 1908 at 269,000 persons, the consumption per head of wheat for human food, poultry food, etc., on the basis of the past year's experience, at 8 bushels, and the seed requirements still at 500,000 bushels, it will be seen that not only ought the total needs of the State probably to have been fully met by the quantities of wheat and flour available at the end of the past harvest season, but also a surplus quantity of wheat and flour, equivalent to 693,317 bushels of wheat, should have been available for export.

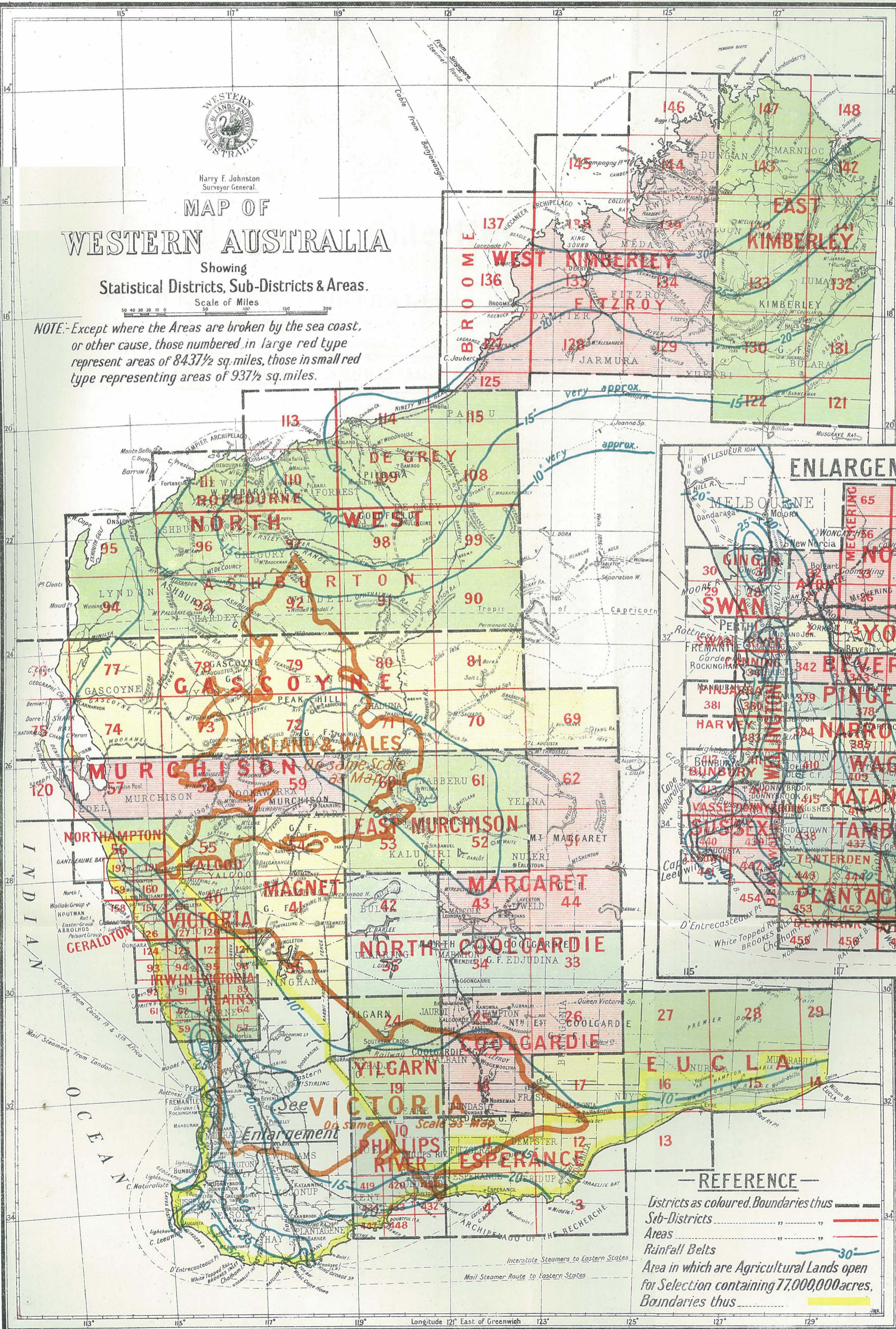
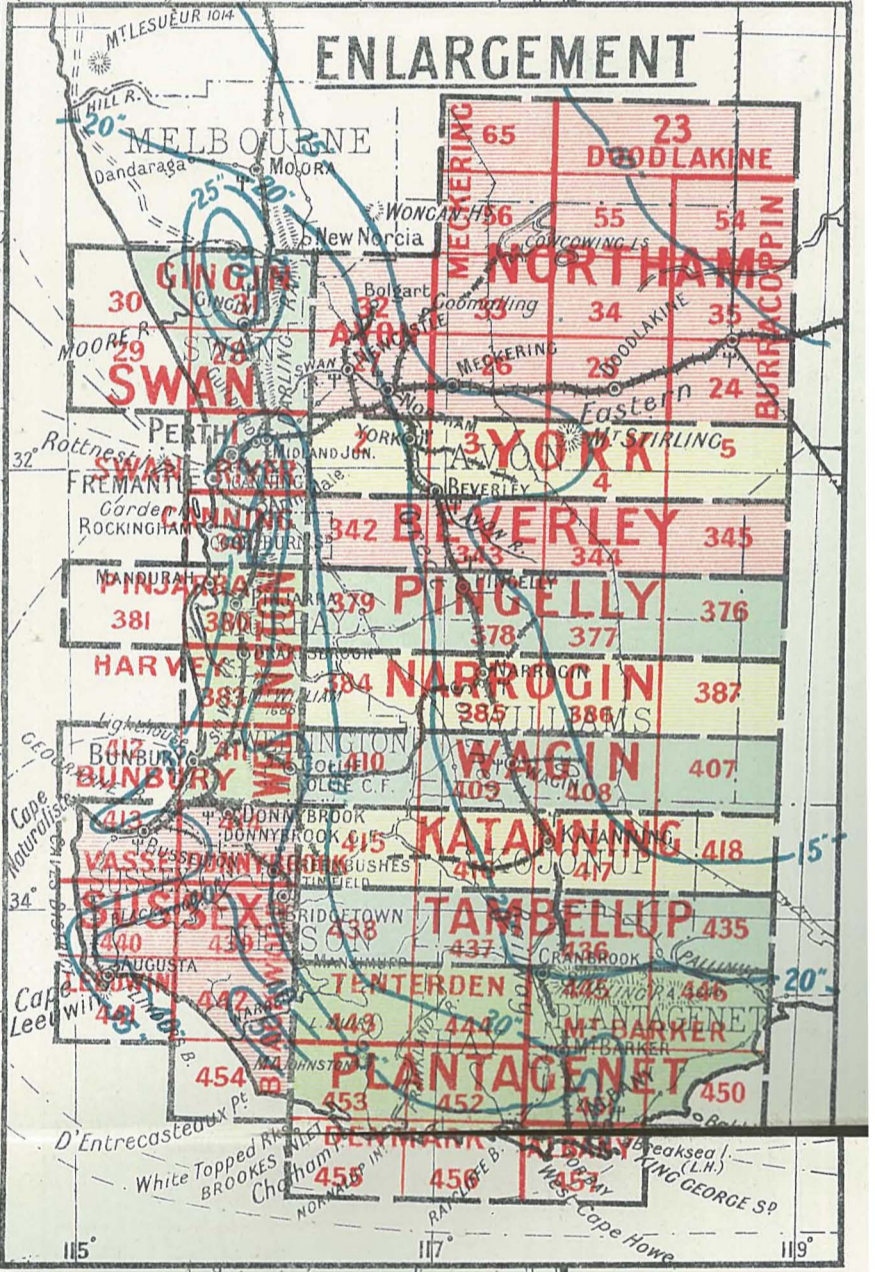
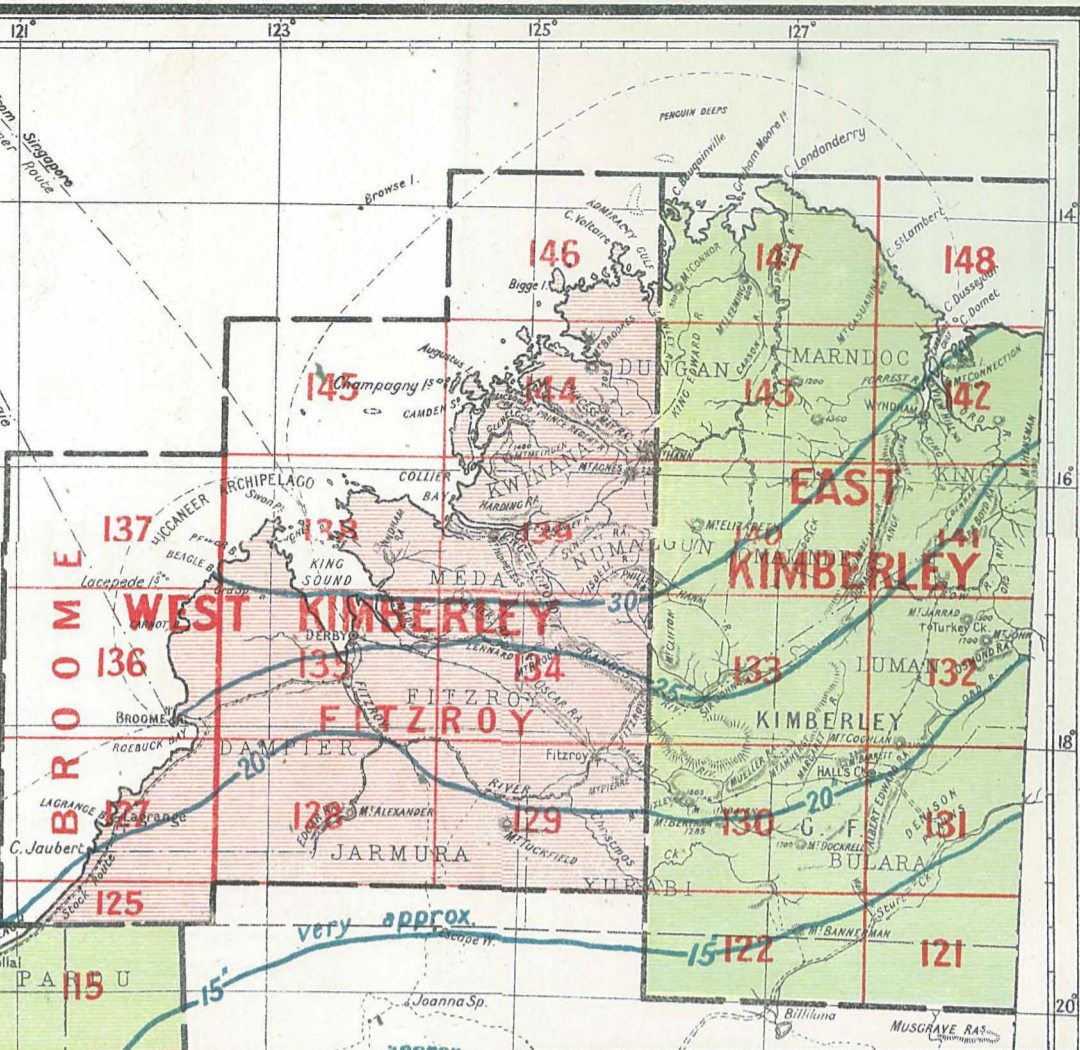
