PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, TO WIT. By His Excellency Admiral Sir Frederick George Denham Bedford, Knight

Grand Cross of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor in and

over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, etc., etc., etc.

WHEREAS under the provisions of "The Constitution Act, 1889," it is made lawful for the Governor of Western Australia for the time being to fix the place and time for holding the first and every other Session of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly : And whereas the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly now stand prorogued to Thursday, the 29th day of October, instant : Now I, Admiral Sir Frederick George Denham Bedford, G.C.B., Governor of the said State, in exercise of the powers so vested in me, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, do by this my Proclamation further prorogue the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly to Tuesday, the 10th day of November now next ensuing; And I do hereby further announce and proclaim that the First Session of the Seventh Parliament of Western Australia shall be holden for the despatch of business on the aforesaid Tuesday, the 10th day of November next, at the hour of twelve o'clock noon; the Session of the Legislative Council to be holden in the Legislative Council Chamber, and the Session of the Legislative Assembly to be holden in the Legislative Council Chamber, and the Session of the Legislative Assembly to be holden in the Legislative Council and the Members of the Legislative Assembly are hereby required to give their attendance at the said time and places accordingly.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this twenty-fourth day of October, One thousand nine hundred and eight.
