WHEREAS by a Proclamation dated the 2nd day of May, 1855, in pursuance of authority vested in Her late Most Gracious Majesty Queen Victoria, Charles Fitzgerald, Esquire, Governor of the Colony, did thereby proclaim that, having awarded full and satisfactory compensation therefor, he had that day resumed, for purpose of public utility and convenience, the land hereunder described, that is to say, twenty acres, more or less, forming a part of the Williams River Location Q, and bounded on the West by a bridge across the River Williams about 13 chains below the mouth of MacDermott's Brook, then by a line of about 96 links extending South 11½deg. West from South corner pile of said bridge, thence by a line of about 6½ chains extending South 20deg. East, and then by a line of about five chains extending South 29deg. East; on the South by an East line of about 12½ chains; on the East by a North line of about 14 chains crossing MacDermott's Brook aforesaid, and on the North by a line of about 5 chains 95 links extending West to Williams River aforesaid through centre of a stout squared post 95 links East from middle of the river's bed, and then by said river downwards to the bridge hereinbefore first mentioned, all bearings and boundaries being true or thereabouts, and a stout squared post being placed at all corners of the land above described. And whereas the boundaries set out therein were erroneously described And whereas it is desirable that such erroneous description should be rectified: Now therefore I, Admiral Sir Frederick George Denham Bedford, G.C.B., Governor as aforesaid, proclaim that I do hereby confirm the resumption as aforesaid, and so far as may be necessary do hereby resume, for purposes of public utility and convenience, the land hereunder described (full and satisfactory compensation having been already awarded therefor), that is to say:—

Twenty-one and a-half acres, more or less, forming part of Williams Location Q and bounded by lines starting from a point on the left bank of the Williams River situate at its intersection with the East side of the main Perth to Albany Road, said point being also situate about 518 chains 30 links North, and about 41 chains 30 links West from the South-East corner of aforesaid Location Q, and extending along the aforesaid Perth to Albany Road 214deg. 48min. about two

chains 20 links; 160deg. 18min. 6 chains 88 8/10 links; 150deg. 9min. 4 chains 24 3/10 links; thence 90deg. 38min. 18 chains 58 5/10 links; thence 35min. 14 chains 4 links; thence 268deg. 29min. about 5 chains 95 links to the aforesaid left bank of the Williams River, and thence along the said bank to the starting point.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, this 16th day of December, 1908.

WHEREAS by Section 116 of "The Health Act, 1898," upon proof by the certificate in writing of an officer of health that any infectious disease exists within or without a Local Board's district, and that there is danger that the same may spread, and that to prevent the spreading thereof it is necessary to the public safety that power should be given to isolate any tenements, the Governor may make an order empowering and directing such persons as the Central Board may for that purpose appoint to stop the traffic into or through any streets, thoroughfares, or places, whether public or private, which the Central Board shall specify, and to prevent ingress, egress, or regress of any persons to or from any house or premises within the streets, thoroughfares, or places as specified, supplying the inmates with proper and sufficient food and domestic necessities, for so long as shall seem to the Central Board necessary for the public safety: And whereas proof has been given as aforesaid that diphtheria, an infectious disease under the provisions of "The Health Act, 1898," exists at several places situated both within and without the districts of various Local Boards: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Central Board, hereby empowers and directs such persons as the Central Board may for that purpose appoint to stop the traffic into or through any streets, thoroughfares, or places, whether public or private, which the Central Board shall specify, and to limit or prevent ingress, egress, or regress of any persons to or from any house or premises within the streets, thoroughfares, or places so specified, supplying the inmates with proper and sufficient food and domestic necessities, for so long as shall seem to the Central Board necessary for the public safety.

With reference to my predecessor's Circular despatch of 20th September, 1907, I have the honour to transmit to you, for the information of your Ministers, copies of a notice issued by the Nobel Committee of the Norwegian Parliament with regard to the nomination of candidates for the Nobel Peace Prize of 1909.

2. I have to request that your Ministers will be so good as to cause the conditions of the prize to be made known to those bodies and persons who are qualified to nominate candidates.

3. It will be observed that the names of candidates should be received by the Nobel Committee of the Norwegian Parliament before the 1st of February, 1909.

NOBEL PEACE PRIZE.

All proposals of candidates for the Nobel Peace Prize, which is to be distributed 10th December, 1909, must, in order to be taken into consideration, be laid before the Nobel Committee of the Norwegian Parliament by a duly qualified person *before the first of February of the same year.*

Any one of the following persons is held to be duly qualified: (a) Members and late members of the Nobel Committee of the Norwegian Parliament, as well as the advisers appointed at the Norwegian Nobel Institute; (b) Members of Parliament and Members of the Government of the different States, as well as Members of the Interparliamentary Union; (c) Members of the international Arbitration Court at the Hague; (d) Members of the Commission of the Permanent International Peace Bureau; (e) Members and Associates of the Institute of International Law; (f) University professors

of Political Science and of Law, of History and of Philosophy; and (g) Persons who have received the Nobel Peace Prize.

The Nobel Peace Prize may also be accorded to institutions or associations.

According to the Code of Statutes, Sec. 8, the grounds upon which any proposal is made must be stated, and handed in along with such papers and other documents as may therein be referred to.

According to Sec. 3, every written work, to qualify for a prize, must have appeared in print.

For particulars, *qualified persons* are requested to apply to the office of the Nobel Committee of the Norwegian Parliament, Drammensvei 19, Kristiania.
