NOTICE is hereby given that at a Special Meeting of the Executive Council, held at the Perth Town Hall on Monday, 31st May, 1909, a Commission issued under the Royal Sign Manual and Signet, appointing Sir Gerald Strickland, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor of the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, was read by the Clerk as follows:—

Edward the Seventh, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India: To Our Trusty and Well-beloved Sir Gerald Strickland, Count Della Catena, Knight Commander of Our Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Greeting:

We do by this Our Commission under Our Siga Manual and Signet appoint you, the said Sir Gerald Strickland, to be, during Our pleasure, Our Governor in and over Our State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia, with all the powers, rights, privileges, and advantages to the said Office belonging or appertaining.

II. And We do hereby authorise, empower, and command you to exercise and perform all and singular the powers and directions contained in certain Letters Patent under the Great Seal of Our United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, bearing date at Westminster the twenty-ninth day of October, 1900, constituting the Office of Governor in and over Our State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia, or in any other Letters Patent adding to amending, or substituted for the same, and according to such Orders and Instructions as the Governor for the time being of the said State hath already received, or as you may hereafter receive from Us.

III. And We do hereby appoint that so soon as you shall have taken the prescribed oaths, and have entered upon the duties of your Office, this Our present Commission shall supersede the Commission under Our Sign Manual and Signet, hearing date the sixteenth day of January, 1903, appointing Our Trusty and Well-beloved Sir Frederick George Denham Bedford, Admiral in Our Royal Navy, Knight Grand Cross of Our Most Honour-

able Order of the Bath, to be Governor of Our State of Western Australia and its Dependencies.

1V. And We do hereby command all and singular Our Officers, Ministers, and loving subjects in Our said State and its Dependencies, and all others whom it may concern, to take due notice hereof, and to give their ready obedience accordingly.

Given at Our Court at Saint James's, this Sixth day of April, 1909, in the Ninth year of Our Reign.

Commission appointing Sir Gerald Strickland, K.C.M.G., to be Governor of the State of Western Australia.

His Excellency was then sworn in before His Honour the Chief Justice, and thereupon issued the following Proclamation:—

## PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, TO WIT.

G. STRICKLAND, Governor.

By His Excellency Sir Gerald Strickland, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, etc., etc., etc.

WHEREAS by certain Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland bearing date at Westminster, 29th October, 1900, our late Majesty Queen Victoria was pleased to constitute the Office of Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, and that the person who should fill the said office of Governor should be from time to time appointed by Commission under Her Majesty's Sign Manual and Signet: And whereas His present Majesty King Edward VII. was further pleased by a Commission under His Royal Sign Manual and Signet bearing date at St. James, sixth day of April, 1909, to appoint me, Sir Gerald Strickland, to be the Governor

of the said State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, with all and singular the powers and authorities conferred on the Governor of the said State in the above recited Letters Patent: And whereas I have this day taken the oath prescribed by the said Letters Patent, in the form and manner therein set out: Now I do hereby proclaim and make known that all and singular the powers and authorities conferred by the said Letters ratent have devolved upon me, the said Sir Gerald Strickland, as Governor of the said State of Western Australia: And I further proclaim that I have this day assumed the Government of the said State, and all and singular His Majesty's Officers, Ministers, and Subjects in the said State, and all others whom it may concern,

are required to take due notice thereof and to give their obedience accordingly.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, this 31st day of May, in the year of Our Lord, 1909.
