WHEREAS it is provided by "The Game Act, 1892," that the Governor may, with the advice of the Executive Council, from time to time, by Proclamation to be published in the "Government Gazette," declare the close season for any particular native game included in the First Schedule of the said Act, either generally throughout the State, or in any one or more portions thereof, to be defined in any such proclamation: Now therefore I, Sir Gerald Strickland, K.C.M.G., Governor as aforesaid, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby declare that within the whole State of Western Australia the close season for opossums shall be from the first day of March to the 31st day of October, both days inclusive, in each and every year.

WHEREAS by "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1906," it is provided that for the government of every municipality there shall be a council which shall consist, where the population of the municipal district is declared by the Governor to be under one thousand, of a mayor and six councillors, and that the Governor may from time to time, by Order in Council, determine and alter, within the limits prescribed by the Act, the number of councillors assigned to any municipality: And whereas a petition, signed with the common seal of the Municipal Council of Mount Morgans, has been presented to His Excellency the Governor, praying that the population of the municipal district of Mount Morgans be declared to be under one thousand, and that the number of councillors be accordingly reduced from nine to six: And whereas the said petition was published in the *Government Gazette* on the 11th June, 1909: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby declares the population of the Municipal District of Mount Morgans to be under one thousand, and orders that the Municipal Council of Mount Morgans shall consist of a Mayor and six Councillors.

GOVERNMENT SAVINGS BANK.

HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council has been pleased to repeal, under the provisions of the Government Savings Bank Act, No. 9 of 1906, Regulation 25, and approve of the following in lieu thereof:—

25. Any depositor who desires—

- (a.) To transfer the whole or any part of his deposit to be placed to his credit at a Savings Bank in the United Kingdom or in one of the other States of the Commonwealth, or
- (b.) To withdraw the whole or any part of his deposit at a Savings Bank in the United Kingdom or in one of the other States in the Commonwealth,

will be required—

- (1.) To attend at the Head Office, or a Branch Office, or an Agency;
- (2.) To leave his pass-book in the custody of the official, taking a receipt therefor;
- (3.) To fill in and sign the necessary form.

Provided that reciprocal arrangements exist on the part of the Treasurer and the United Kingdom or such other State; and provided further, that the amount transferred or withdrawn under this regulation does not exceed the maximum amount prescribed in the United Kingdom or such other State.

In urgent cases within the Commonwealth any sum not exceeding Ten pounds may be withdrawn under this regulation by telegraph upon the depositor proving his identity and complying with the regulations; but no depositor may withdraw by telegraph oftener than once in three days.

The current bank rate of exchange will be deducted from the amount remitted or transferred.

Also to repeal paragraph 5 of Regulation 30, and approve of the insertion of the following words in lieu thereof:—

- (5.) No deposit will be received from any pupil who is unable to sign his name.

THE Regulations made by the Fremantle Harbour Trust Commissioners, and dated the 6th day of September, 1907, are hereby amended as follows, such amendment to come into force on the 10th day of July, 1909:—

REGULATION No. 117 AMENDED.

*Motor Cars.*

Motor cars which have once paid a full inward wharfage rate at Fremantle, and which are being shipped from the Port for the owner's private use, or which

are again landed at the Port for the owner's private use, shall only be charged one-half the scheduled rate of wharfage. To obtain this concession, the owner or his agent must give such proof as shall satisfy the Secretary of the Trust that he is entitled to such concession.

THE Municipal Council of Kookynie, in pursuance of the powers vested in it and by virtue of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1906," hereby publishes the following By-laws for regulating the Collection of Rates, and numbered 72 and 73:—

72. A discount at the rate of five pounds per centum will be allowed to all persons whose rates are paid within thirty days of the date prescribed in the notice.

73. Where any rates have remained unpaid for a period of twelve months after the same became due and payable, such rates shall thereafter bear interest at the rate of five pounds per centum per annum calculated at simple interest, and such interest shall be recoverable in the same manner as rates are recoverable under the provisions of this Act.

3. The brand shall be in the form of the diagram hereunder, with a numeral in the centre corresponding to the number allotted by the Board to the Inspector:—



4. The fee to be paid for the inspection and branding of any carcase shall be in accordance with the schedule attached hereto, and such fee shall be payable, on demand by the Board or an Inspector, by the occupier of the slaughter-house or abattoir in which the slaughtering was carried out, and such fees shall be recoverable in default of payment as penalties under the principal Act are recoverable.

5. These Regulations shall come into force as from the first day of August, 1909.
