WHEREAS by Sections 222 and 227 of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1906" (6 Edwardi, No. 32), it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request of the Coun-

DERBY LOCAL BOARD OF HEALTH.

By-laws.

WHEREAS a Local Board of Health may make By-laws under the provisions of "The Health Act, 1898," and its amendments, and may alter, repeal, or amend its By-laws so made: Now, therefore, the Local Board of Health, Derby, hereby amends its By-laws so published in the *Government Gazette* of the 15th July, 1910, as follows:—

Schedule "A."

Schedule of Charges for Sanitary Work, Rubbish Removal, etc.

is hereby amended to read as follows:—

For the removal, cleansing, carting, and replacing each pan within the district of the Local Board of Health: At per pan, 1s. 3d.

For the removal and disposal of trade refuse, *i.e.*, refuse which may have accumulated on any premises from or through any business, manufacture, or trade carried on, on such premises: At per cubic yard, 5s.

For the removal and disposal of household refuse, per week: At per three cubic feet, 9d.
