Regulations under the Roads Act, 1911.

WHEREAS it is enacted by "The Roads Act, 1911," that the Governor may make regulations for giving effect to the said Act, and prescribing the forms for use under the said Act: And whereas the said Act is to commence on the 1st day of July, 1911, and it is desirable and expedient for the purpose of bringing such Act into operation at the date of the commencement thereof to exercise the power of making regulations hereinbefore mentioned: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the State of Western Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, doth hereby, in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act and of all other powers him in this behalf enabling, make and enact the regulations following, that is to say:—

1. The several forms contained in the Schedule hereto shall be used for the purposes for which they are respectively applicable.

Provided that the rate book and other books prescribed by the regulations made under Section 24 of "The Roads Act Amendment Act, 1904," may be continued in use for such time as the Minister may think fit, with such modifications (if any) as the Minister may direct.

2. After a rate book has been made up and completed, the Secretary shall make a note thereof in the book indicating the date of completion and the rates for which the book is to serve and be made use of.

3. When, after the making of the general rates, it is deemed necessary to make any additional rate or by virtue of Section 241 of the said Act to extend any rates to a transferred area, the Board shall make up and complete the rate book for the purposes of such rate or extension, making such alterations and additions (if any) as shall be judged necessary, but without obliterating existing entries.

4. The Secretary shall thereupon make a note in the rate book indicating:—

- (a) the date of such completion;
- (b) the additional rate (if any) for which the book so completed is to serve;
- (c) the area (if any) to which any rates are extended; and
- (d) the date of transfer of any such area to the district.

5. Notwithstanding anything herein, the columns numbered 7 to 13 (both inclusive), in the form of rate book in the Schedule, shall not be deemed portion of the "rate book" for the purposes of the said Act, but entries may be made therein from time to time as may be convenient by the Secretary or any other person authorised by the Board in that behalf.

6. The time to be allowed to any person aggrieved by any such alteration, addition, or amendment as is mentioned in Section 213 of the Act to appeal against the same shall be one month from the receipt of the notice mentioned in Subsection (5) of the said Section.

7. A notice of appeal under Division 5 of Part VI. of the said Act may be a general notice of appeal, and need not specify the particular entries appealed against; but all such entries as are affected by the decision on the appeal shall be altered so as to accord with such decision.

8. Care is to be taken that, so far as practicable, entries concerning lands in different wards or lands valued on different systems, or lands rated at different figures are not intermingled in the rate book, but are kept in distinct parts thereof.

9. All notices of the making up of rate books and of assessment shall be made out in duplicate, and one copy shall be retained by the Secretary of the Board, who shall make a note thereon of the date of the service of the notice.

10. Non-compliance with these regulations shall not render any act or proceeding of the Board or any officer or member thereof void, but if the same would, apart from these regulations, be valid, it shall, notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing regulations, be taken to be a good and valid act or proceeding.

11. These regulations may be cited as "The Roads Act Regulations, 1911."

PERTH CAUSEWAY OVER SWAN RIVER.

IT is hereby notified that the Governor in Council under the provisions of "The Public Works Act, 1902," has been pleased to direct and determine:—
(a.) That the bridges (including the approaches thereto) crossing the Swan River and connecting the City of Perth with the Municipality of Victoria Park, known as the Perth Causeway, shall from and after the 1st day of July, 1911, be under the exclusive care, control, and management of the Council of the Municipality of Victoria Park; and
(b.) That the cost to be incurred by the Council of the Municipality of Victoria Park in maintaining and repairing the said bridges and the approaches thereto shall be provided and paid by the Council of the Municipality of Victoria Park and the Council of the Municipality of the City of Perth in equal shares; and
(c.) That the moiety of the cost of maintaining and repairing the said bridges and the approaches thereto shall be provided and paid from time to time by the Council of the Municipality of the City of Perth to the Council of the Municipality of Victoria Park on demand.
