Division into Wards.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, this
13th day of November, 1911.

WHEREAS by Section 12, Subsection (2), of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1906," the Governor is empowered to divide any municipal district into wards and define the boundaries thereof: And whereas a petition has been presented to His Excellency the Governor, praying that the Municipality of Queen's Park be divided into three wards, signed by not fewer than one-third of the persons on the municipal roll of the said Municipality: And whereas the said petition was publicly advertised in the *Government Gazette* on the 10th day of October, 1911: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers so vested in him by the said Act, does hereby divide the said Municipality into three wards, to be known as the West Ward, the Central Ward, and the East Ward, respectively, and

declare the boundaries of the said wards to be as follows:—

West Ward.—Bounded on the Northward by the Northern boundaries of the Municipality. On the South-Eastward by a line along the North-Western boundary of Sub. Lot 337, the centres of Mills Street, Perth-Albany Road, Burton Street, Chapman Road, the South-Eastern and South-Western boundaries of Sub. Lot 31, and the centre of Watts Street, and on the Southward and Westward by the Southern and Western boundaries of the Municipality.

Central Ward.—Bounded on the North Westward by a line along the centre of Watts Street, the South-Western and South-Eastern boundaries of Sub. Lot 31, the centres of Chapman Road, Burton Street, Perth-Albany Road, Mills Street, the North-Western boundary of Sub. Lot 337, and part of the North-Western boundary of the Municipality. On the North-Eastward by part of the North-Eastern boundary of the Municipality. On the South-Eastward by a line along the centre of Wharf Street, and on the Southward by part of the Southern boundary of the Municipality.

East Ward.—Bounded on the North-Westward by a line along the centre of Wharf Street. On the North-Eastward by part of the North-Eastern boundary of the Municipality. On the South-Eastward by the South-Eastern boundary of the Municipality, and on the South-Westward by part of the South-Western boundary of the Municipality.
