NOTICE is hereby given that at a Poll taken in the Metropolitan Shop District on Wednesday, the 24th day of January, 1912, under the provisions of "The Early Closing Act, 1902," as amended by Act No. 1 of 1912, on the resolution "Do you vote that shops generally throughout the District shall close at 1 o'clock on Saturday," 9,305 electors voted "Yes" and 3,158 electors voted "No," and the resolution was therefore carried by a majority of 6,147.
