By His Excellency Major General Sir Harry Barron, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of "The Bank Holidays Act, 1884," I, the Governor of the said State, do by this my Proclamation appoint special days to be observed as Bank Holidays as follows:—

Date and Town. Saturday, 29th March, 1913, Quairading. Friday, 4th April, 1913, Moora. Wednesday, 23rd April, 1913, Boulder. Wednesday, 7th May, 1913, Kalgoorlic.
