WHEREAS by Section 194, Subsection 7, of "The Roads Act, 1911," it shall be lawful for the Governor to declare any land to be exempt from the Road Rates, and such lands shall thereupon and thenceforth become exempt from rates within the meaning of such Act: And whereas the Osborne Park Local Board of Health has requested that certain land named and described in the schedule hereunder, within the Road District of Perth, be exempted from Road Rates under the said Act: Now therefore I, the said Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby, in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, declare the said lands or parts thereof to be exempt from Road Rates, during such time as such land or part or parts thereof remain in the possession of the Osborne Park Local Board of Health and is used exclusively for purposes of Public Sanitary Site, under the provisions of "The Health Act, 1911"; also that no rent or other fees are derived therefrom except by sale of such land or parts thereof, and shall from the date hereof be exempt from Road Rates accordingly.
