WHEREAS by the Control of Trade in War Time Act it is provided that the Governor, on the advice of the Royal Commission appointed under the said Act, may, Royal Commission appointed under the said Act, may, by Order in Council, fix the maximum price that may be lawfully charged for the necessaries of life: And whereas it is desirable to fix the maximum price of Milk in the Metropolitan Area: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby fix the maximum price to be charged for fresh milk in the Metropolitan Area as follows:—Wholesale: Maximum selling price to be charged by producers to retailers or distributors. Area as follows:—Wholesale: Maximum selling price to be charged by producers to retailers or distributors, 1s. 2d. (One shilling and twopence) per gallon, delivered at any railway station within the said area. Retail: Maximum selling price to be charged by retailers or distributors to consumers, within the said area, 6½d. (Sixpence halfpenny) per quart. The conditions of trade as existing on the 1st August, 1915, shall not be

varied without the consent of the Royal Commission appointed as aforesaid, on application made to the Commission in that behalf. For the purposes of this Order the Metropolitan Area means any land situated within twelve miles of the General Post Office, Perth.
