ACT OF PARLIAMENT ASSENTED TO.

Sale of Liquor Regulation Act, 1915.

IT is hereby notified, for general information, that on the 10th day of January, 1916, His Excellency the Governor, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty, assented to the undermentioned Act passed by the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly in Parliament assembled, namely:—

“An Act to amend the Licensing Act, 1911, and to Regulate the Closing Time for the Sale or Supply of Liquor on Licensed Premises, and in State Hotels, Refreshment Rooms, Restaurant Cars, Vessels for which Packet Licenses are held, and Registered Clubs, during War Time.”
