PROCLAMATION

Western Australia, By His Excellency Major General Sir Harry Barron, Knight Commander of the Most
TO WIT.

Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Commander of the Royal Victorian Order,
Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of "The Bank Holidays Act, 1884," I, the Governor of the said State, do by this my Proclamation appoint Saturday, 3rd June, 1916, a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout the State.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this 29th day of May, 1916.
