PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency the Right Honourto WIT.

By His Excellency the Right Honourwilliam Grey EllisonMacartney, Privy Councillor, Knight
Commander of the Most Distinguished
Order of St. Michael and St. George,
Governor in and over the State of
Western Australia and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by "The Electoral Act, 1907," it is provided that new Rolls for any Province or District and new Rolls generally shall be prepared under the supervision of, and issued by the Chief Electoral Officer, whereas districted by Province and shall come into whenever directed by Proclamation, and shall come into operation at a date to be stated in the same or any subsequent Proclamation: And whereas the Chief Electoral Officer was directed by Proclamation, dated the sixteenth day of January, One thousand nine hundred and eighteen, to prepare under his supervision and issue new Rolls for each Province: And whereas such new Rolls have now been so prepared and issued: Now therefore I, the said Governor, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby fix Wednesday, the first day of May, One thousand nine hundred and eighteen, as the date upon which such new Rolls for each Province shall come into operation.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, the twenty-fourth day of April, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighteen.
