PROCLAMATIONS.

Prorogation of Parliament.

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, } By His Excellency the Right Honour-

WHEREAS by "The Constitution Act, 1889," it is provided that it shall be lawful for the Governor to prorogue the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly from time to time, by Proclamation or otherwise, whenever he shall think fit: Now therefore I, the said Governor, in exercise of the power conferred by the said Act, do hereby further prorogue the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly until the 22nd day of August next.

Parliament Summoned to Meet for Business.

WHEREAS under the provisions of "The Constitution Act, 1889," it is made lawful for the Governor of Western Australia to fix the time and place for the

holding of the first and every other session of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly: And whereas the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly stand prorogued to Thursday, the 22nd day of August next: Now therefore I, the said Governor, in exercise of the power so vested in me, and of all other powers enabling me in this behalf, do by this my Proclamation announce and proclaim that the Second Session of the Tenth Parliament of Western Australia shall be holden for the despatch of business on the said Thursday, the 22nd day of August, 1918, at the hour of 3 o'clock in the afternoon, in the House of Parliament, in the City of Perth: And members of the Legislative Council and members of the Legislative Assembly are hereby required to give their attendance at the said time and place accordingly.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this 24th day of July, 1918.
