PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency the Right Honourto Wit. Sable Sir William Grey EllisonMacartney, Privy Councillor, Knight
Commander of the Most Distinguished
Order of St. Michael and St. George,
Governor in and over the State of
Western Australia and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of "The Bank Holidays Act, 1884," I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint Tuesday and Wednesday, the 12th and 13th days of November, 1918, to be observed as Special Bank Holidays throughout the State.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this twelfth day of November, 1918.
