Bank Holiday in the Metropolitan Area. 311/18.

1N pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of "The Bank Holidays Act, 1884," 1, the Governor of the said State, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint

Wednesday, the 20th November, 1918,

a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday in the Metropolitan Area, that is to say, the Metropolitan, the Metropolitan-Suburban, and the West Electoral Provinces.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this 19th day of November, 1918.
