Parliament Summoned to meet for Business.

WHEREAS under the provisions of "The Constitution Act, 1889," it is lawful for the Governor of Western Australia to fix the place and time for holding every session of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assession of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly: And whereas the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly now stand prorogued to Thursday, the thirty-first day of July instant: Now therefore I, the said Governor, in exercise of the power vested in me and all other powers enabling me in that behalf, do by this my proclamation announce and proclaim that the Third Session of the Tenth Parliament of Western Australia shall be holden for the despatch of business on Thursday, the thirty-first day of July instant, in the House of Parliament, in the City of Perth, and Members of the Legislative Council are hereby required to give attendance at the Legislative Council Chamber at twelve o'clock noon on the said thirty-first day of July instant, and Members of the Legislative Assembly are hereby required to give their attendance at the Legislative Assembly Chamber at twelve o'clock noon, on the said thirty-first day of July instant, accordingly.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this 16th day of July, 1919.
