PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, TO WIT.

By His Excellency the Right Honourable Sir William Grey Ellison-Macartney, Privy Councilior, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by the Licensing Act Amendment Act, 1914, it is provided that the Governor may from time to time by Proclamation restrict or prohibit the sale, offer for sale, supply or gift of liquor, either alone or mixed with water or other liquid, within any Licensing District: AND WHEREAS it is desirable to prohibit the sale as aforesaid of liquor in the Licensing District of Kalgoorlie on Saturday, the 13th day of

December instant: Now therefore I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, in exercise of the power conferred by the Licensing Act Amendment Act, 1914, do hereby prohibit the sale, offer for sale, supply or gift of liquor within the meaning of that term in the Licensing Act, 1911, either alone or mixed with water or other liquid, within the Licensing District of Kalgoorlie on Saturday, the 13th day of December instant.
