ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Executive Council Chamber, in Perth, this 5th day of March, 1920.

The Minister for Education (Senior Member). The Honourables—The Minister for Mines. The Colonial Secretary.

WHEREAS by "The Prices Regulation Act, 1919," it is provided that the Governor may, on the recommendation of the Commissioners, determine the maximum prices which may be charged for foodstuffs and necessary commodities in any proclaimed area : Now, therefore, His Excellency the Administrator, on the recommendation of the Commissioners appointed under the said Act and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby determine that the prices of the foodstuffs and necessary commodities mentioned in the schedule hereto shall be the maximum prices that may be charged for such foodstuffs and necessary commodities within the metropolitan area and other proclaimed areas.
