NOTICE is hereby given that, at the Special Meeting of the Executive Council held at Government House on Friday, the 9th day of April, 1920, at 12 o'clock noon, His Excellency the Administrator reported that he had received from His Majesty's Secretary of State for the Colonies a Commission under the Royal Sign Manual and Signet appointing him Governor of Western Australia, which Commission was read by the Clerk as follows:—

Western Australia.

Commission passed under the Royal Sign Manual and Signet, appointing Sir Francis Alexander Newdigate Newdegate, K.C.M.G., to be Governor of the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia.

Dated 21st January, 1920.

George the Fifth by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India: To Our Trusty and Well-beloved Sir Francis Alexander Newdigate Newdegate, Knight Commander of Our Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Greeting.

We do, by this Our Commission under Our Sign Manual and Signet, appoint you, the said Sir Francis Alexander Newdigate Newdegate, to be, during Our pleasure, Our Governor in and over Our State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia, with all the powers, rights, privileges, and advantages to the said Office belonging or appertaining.

II. And We do hereby authorise, empower, and command you to exercise and perform all and singular the powers and directions contained in certain Letters Patent under the Great Seal of Our United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, bearing date at Westminster the Twenty-ninth day of October, 1900, constituting the Office of Governor in and over Our State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia, or in any other Letters Patent adding to, amending, or substituted for the same, and according

to such Orders and Instructions as the Governor for the time being of the said State hath already received, or as you may hereafter receive from Us.

III. And We do hereby appoint that so soon as you shall have taken the prescribed Oaths, and have entered upon the duties of your Office of Governor, this Our present Commission shall supersede Our Commission under Our Sign Manual and Signet bearing date the Nineteenth day of February, 1917, appointing Our Right Trusty and Well-beloved Counsellor Sir William Grey Ellison-Macartney, Knight Commander of Our Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, to be Governor of Our State of Western Australia and its Dependencies.

IV. And we do hereby command all and singular Our Officers, Ministers, and loving subjects in Our said State and its Dependencies, and all others whom it may concern, to take due notice hereof, and to give their ready obedience accordingly.

Given at Our Court at Saint James's, this Twenty-first day of January, 1920, in the Tenth Year of Our Reign.

WHEREAS by certain Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, bearing date at Westminster the 29th day of October, 1900, Her late Majesty Queen Victoria did constitute, order, and declare that there shall be a Gov-

ernor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies as therein defined, and the Governor was thereby authorised, empowered, and commanded to do and execute all things belonging to his said office, as therein more particularly set forth:

And whereas His Majesty King George the Fifth has been pleased, by a Commission under His Royal Sign Manual and Signet bearing date at His Court of St. James's the 21st day of January, 1920, to appoint me, Sir Francis Alexander Newdigate Newdigate, to be Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, during His Majesty's pleasure, and has by the said Commission authorised, empowered, and commanded me to exercise and perform all and singular the powers and directions contained in the hereinbefore recited Letters Patent:

And whereas I have, as provided by the said Commission, duly taken the Oaths prescribed to be taken by the said recited Letters Patent, in the form and manner therein set forth, now I do hereby proclaim and make known that all and singular the powers and authorities conferred by the said Letters Patent have devolved upon me, the said Sir Francis Alexander Newdigate Newdigate, as Governor of the said State of Western Australia:

And I further proclaim that I have this day assumed the Government of the said State, and all and singular His Majesty's Officers, Ministers, and Subjects in the said State and all others whom it may concern are required to take due notice thereof and give obedience accordingly.

Alteration of Boundaries.

WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 8 of "The Road Districts Act, 1919," it is enacted that the Administrator may, by Order in Council, alter the boundary of any Road District or Ward, and transfer portion thereof to another Road District or Ward: And whereas it is desirable to alter the boundaries of the Wyndham and Hall's Creek Road Districts by transferring from the latter to the former Road District the territory described and defined in the Schedule hereto: And whereas due notice of the intention of the Administrator in Executive Council to exercise such power has, in accordance with the provisions of "The Road Districts Act, 1919," been duly published in the *Government Gazette* and served on the Boards concerned, in the manner prescribed in the said Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Administrator, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, under the provisions of Section 8 of "The Road Districts Act, 1919," and of all other powers enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby alter and amend the respective boundaries of the Wyndham and Hall's Creek Road Districts by transferring from the latter to the former Road District the territory described and defined in the Schedule hereto, and the respective boundaries of the said Districts are hereby altered and amended accordingly.

To come into force on and from the first day of July, 1920.

The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909.

WHEREAS by "The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909," it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works, and Stormwater Drainage Works; and whereas it is further provided that the Governor may exempt reticulation works from certain sections of this Act; Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby approves of the construction and extension by the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage of the following works under the said Act, and does hereby exempt such works from the operations of Sections 20, 21, 22, and 23 of the said Act.

Description and Location of Reticulation Works approved and exempted:

Metropolitan Water Supply.

Extension of Mains in Forrest and Marmion Streets:

Melville Road Board.

Laying of 24¾ chains of 3 inches diameter cast-iron water main along Forrest Street, from Carrington Street to McKimmie Street, and lifting the existing 1½ inches diameter wrought iron main; also laying of 8 chains of 3 inches diameter cast iron water main along Marmion Street, from McKimmie Street Westward to join up with the existing main, together with all valves, hydrants, and necessary apparatus connected therewith, as indicated in red on Plan W.S., S., and D.D. No. 3637.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the 9th day of April, 1920.
