CENSUS OF STOCKS OF JAMS.

NOTICE is hereby given, on the recommendation of the Commissioners appointed under "The Prices Regulation Act, 1919," that all persons holding stocks of imported Jams of Australian Manufacture in quantities of ten (10) dozen tins (27ozs.) or over are required to furnish, on or before noon the 9th August, 1920, returns to the said Commissioners of all such stocks; such returns to state the quantity and the purchase price of each variety of Jams held as at noon on the fourth day of August, 1920.
