ORDER IN COUNCIL.

HIS Excellency the Governor with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recom-

mendation of the Commissioners appointed under "The Prices Regulation Act, 1919," doth hereby revoke as from the 1st November, 1920, the Order in Council made and published in the *Government Gazette* on the twenty-first day of May, 1920, determining the maximum retail prices that may be charged for imported Jams of Australian manufacture.
