THE PRICES REGULATION ACT, 1919.

*Determination of Prices.*

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 10 of "The Prices Regulation Act, 1919," it is enacted that the Governor may by Order in Council determine the maximum prices, whether retail or wholesale, which may be

charged for foodstuffs and necessary commodities in any proclaimed area; Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby determine that the prices of the foodstuff and necessary commodity mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall be the maximum wholesale and retail prices that may be charged for such foodstuff and necessary commodity within the Metropolitan Area and other proclaimed Areas.
