descriptions, books of reference, and estimates of the proposed works to the Governor for approval; and that if they are approved, the Governor may forthwith, by if they are approved, the Governor may forthwith, by Order in Council, empower the Minister to undertake the construction of proposed works: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and con-sent of the Executive Council, hereby approves of the plans, descriptions, books of reference, and estimates marked P.W.D., W.A., 21324, for the construction of works within the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewer-age, and Drainage Area, which were duly submitted for approval, and hereby empowers the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage to undertake the con-struction of the said works. struction of the said works.

The Road Districts Act, 1919. NINGHAN AND MERREDIN ROAD DISTRICTS.

Alteration of Boundaries and the Constitution of the Nungarin Road District.

ORDER IN COUNCIL. P.W. 5963/21.

WHEREAS under the provisions of "The Road Districts Act, 1919," the Governor by Order in Council may—

1. Sever any portion of a Road District therefrom, and either constitute such portion a Road District or annex it to an existing Road District.

Divide or redivide a Road District into Wards.

3. Assign a name to any district or ward.

And whereas it is desirable to-

1. Sever that portion of the Ninghan Road District therefrom, as described in Schedule "A" hereto, and annex such severed portion to the Merredin Road District ; and to sever that portion of the Merredin Road District therefrom, as described in Schedule "B" hereto, and annex such severed portion to the Ninghan Road District.

2. Sever that portion of the Merredin Road District (as amended by Schedules "A" and "B") therefrom, as described in Schedule "C" hereto, and constitute such severed portion a Road District to be called the Nungarin Road District.

3. Divide the said Nungarin Road District into five wards, with the names, boundaries, and number of members allocated as described in Schedule "D" hereto.

4. Re-divide the Merredin Road District when so amended into five wards, with the boundaries, names, and number of members allocated as described in Schedule " E " hereto.

5. Appoint the Chairman of the Merredin Road Board as Returning Officer at the election of the members of the Nungarin Road Board, and to fix the dates for the various events leading up to the said election, as shown in Schedule " \mathbf{F} " hereto.

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, under the provisions of the said Act and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby :---

I. Sover that portion of the Ninghan Road District therefrom, as described in Schedule "A" hereto, and annex such severed portion to the Merredin Road District; and to sever that portion of the Merredin Road District therefrom, as described in Schedule "B" hereto, and annex such severed portion to the Ninghan Road District.

2. Sever that portion of the Merredin Road District (as antended by Schedules "A." and "B.") therefrom, as described in Schedule "C." hereto, and constitute such severed portion a Road District to be called the Nungarin Road District.

 Divide the said Nungarin Road District into five wards, with the names, boundaries, and number of members allocated as described in Schedule "D" hereto.
 4. Re-divide the Merredin Road District, when so

4. Re-divide the Merredin Road District, when so amended, into five wards with the boundaries, names, and number of members allocated as described in Schedule "E" hereto.

5. Appoint the Chairman of the Merredin Road Board as Returning Officer at the election of the members of the Nungarin Road Board, and to fix the date for the various events leading up to the said election, as shown in Schedule "F" hereto.

By-law No. 15.

Horse and Carriage Bazaars.

IN pursuance of the powers in that behalf contained in "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1906," the Mayor and Councillors of the City of Perth hereby order that By-law No. 15 be repealed, and the following substituted therefor:—

1. In the construction of this By-law-

- "Horse and Carriage Bazaar" shall mean any place or premises used or intended to be used for the sale of horses, cattle, carriages, and/or vehicles.
- "Impervious Material" shall mean concrete, granolithic, brick grouted with cement, wood covered with not less than one inch of tar macadam or granite cubes.

2. No person shall keep or maintain any premises as a horse and carriage bazaar unless he shall hold a subsisting license in respect of such premises so to do.

3. Applications for the said license shall be made in the form of Schedule "A" hereto.

4. The City Council may in their discretion refuse or grant such application, and in the latter event shall issue to the applicant a license in the form of Schedule "B" hereto. The said license shall expire on the 31st day of October next after the granting thereof.

5. Every person making application as provided in Clause 2 hereof shall lodge with his application a fee of Five pounds, and upon the refusal of any such application shall be entitled to the return of such fee. Provided that if the license be granted as from the 1st day of May or thereafter in any year only one-half of the said fee shall be paid by the applicant.

6. The occupier of every horse and carriage bazaar shall ..

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- (a.) Provide and maintain, in good order and repair, thereon, stables, stalls, and evelosures sufficient in number for the animals and carriages to be on the premises, and secure enough to provide
- on the premises, and secure chough to provide adequate protection to the public.
 (b) Keep the floors of all stables, stalls, and enclosures on such premises paved with an impervious material to the satisfaction, and in accordance with the requirements of the City Council from time to time.
 (c) Keep and maintain in good order and renain
- (c.) Keep and maintain, in good order and repair, the roofs of all stables, stalls, and enclosures on such premises, which roofs shall be of a water-proof material and fitted with eaves, guttering, and downpipe of sufficient size effectively to carry off all storm or rain water.
- (d.) Provide and maintain, in good order and repair, on such premises, proper drains with such falls and of such capacity as shall be sufficient effectively to carry off from such premises all storm rain or other water.
- (e.) When directed so to do by the City Council or any officer thereof, remove or cause to be removed from the said premises anything which creates or is liable to create a nuisance.
- (f.) At all times maintain, in a clean, safe, and orderly condition, such premises, in accordance with the directions of the City Council or its officer.

Where anything by this By-law is directed to be done or forbidden to be done, or where authority is given to any officer to direct anything to be done or to forbid anything to be done, and such act so directed to be done remains undone, or such act forbidden to be done is done, in every such case the person making such default as to such direction and prohibition re-spectively shall be deemed guilty of a breach of this By-law; and every person guilty of a breach of this By-law shall be liable for every such offence, besides any cost which may be incurred in the taking of proceed-ings against such person guilty of such offence, as well as any costs or expenses which may be incurred in the execution of the work directed to be so executed and not so executed, to a penalty not exceeding Twenty pounds for every breach of any such By-law or to a

penalty not exceeding Two pounds for each day during which such breach shall be committed or continued.
