WHEREAS by "The Water Boards Act, 1904," the Governor is empowered, by Order in Council, to constitute the district of a Local Authority or two or more Local Authorities on any part or parts of such District or Districts a Water Area, under such name as may be directed: And whereas, under the provisions of the

said Act, the Governor may authorise the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage to exercise within a Water Area all the functions of a Water Board: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth hereby constitute an area having the boundaries described in the Schedule beautypeach. cribed in the Schedule hereunder a Water Area, for the purpose of the said Act, under the name of the Dangin Water Area, and does hereby appoint the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage to exercise all the functions of a Water Board under the said Act in such area.

This Order in Council shall take effect on the 29th day of July, 1921.

The Prices Regulation Act, 1919/20.

Determination of Prices.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS under the provisions of "The Prices Regulation Act, 1919," as amended by "The Prices Regulation Act Amendment and Continuance Act, 1920," the Governor may, on the recommendation of the Commissioners, by Order in Council determine the maximum prices, whether retail or wholesale, which may be charged for foodstuffs and necessary commodities in any proclaimed area; and without affecting the generality of the powers conferred may determine such prices on the basis of producing, manufacturing, landed delivery, or other cost, and may declare what items may or may not be included in such cost: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and on the recommendation of the Commissioners, doth hereby determine that the price of

the foodstuff, viz., Bread, 51/2d. per 2lb. loaf cash at bakehouse or shop, mentioned in paragraph (a) of the First Schedule of the Order in Council dated the 20th day of July, 1921, shall be the maximum price for such foodstuff within the Metropolitan Area only, and not as in the said Order in Council mentioned.
