#### PROCLAMATION

Western Australia, | By His Excellency Sir Francis AlexTo Wit. | 5 ander Newdegate, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

M.P.H. 4561/21; Ex. Co. No. 2563.

WHEREAS it is provided by Subsection (2) of Section 102 of "The Factories and Shops Act, 1920," that, subject to the said Act, the day on which all shops affected by the said section shall close at one o'clock shall be Saturday, but that the Governor may by Proclamation at any time and from time to time, on the petition (according to the form in the Sixth Schedule to the said Act) of the majority of the keepers of such shops in any district, substitute in that district for Saturday any other week-day: And whereas a petition in due form has been presented to the Governor by a majority of the keepers of such shops in the Shop District of Busselton, praying that Wednesday may be substituted in that district for Saturday as the day on which such shops shall close at one o'clock, and it is desirable to accede to the prayer of such petition: Now therefore I, the said Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby substitute Wednesday for Saturday in the Busselton Shop District accordingly, and do declare that, subject to the said Act, the day on which all such shops as aforesaid shall close at one o'clock in the afternoon in the said district shall be Wednesday.
